1. Call to Order

The CPDA Annual General Meeting was called to order by Margaret Heinermann at 7:52 p.m.

2. Confirmation of Quorum

Quorum was confirmed, with 35 members in attendance.

3. Approval of Agenda

The agenda was approved by Martin Hulme and Blain Karst, and the motion was carried.

4. Approval of Minutes from the 2025 AGM

The minutes were approved by Hedy Malinowski and Jeff Zackodnik, and the motion was carried.

5. Matters arising from the previous minutes

No matters arising from the previous minutes were brought forward.

6. Old Business

No old business was brought forward.

7. Executive Reports

- a. President

There will be no change to the current league format. Twelve of 23 captains attended the meeting to vote.

WDF ranking was requested for both the Rodeo and Calgary Open. Requests were submitted six months in advance, with multiple follow-up emails sent. No response has been received.

- b. 1st Vice President

The fee for competition rounds has helped reduce no-shows and will continue. Blain asked whether the fee has reduced participation in competition rounds. Gary advised that numbers remain very similar to previous years. It was suggested that fees should be returned if sufficient notice is provided and sections can be adjusted. Gary explained that withdrawals still affect the numbers and structure of each round. Margaret noted that refunds have been provided in some cases for valid or uncontrollable reasons. The league's average player age was reviewed. It was noted that the league should continue to focus on attracting younger players and supporting growth. The league is in a strong position and sound financial standing for the upcoming year.

- c. 2nd Vice President

Logan was travelling from work in Canmore and was not in attendance when reports were presented.

- d. Treasurer

Jeff asked how the CPDA, as a not-for-profit league, is able to carry a balance each year. It was explained that the league may carry a balance but should not continue to grow that balance year over year or generate a profit. Funds received by the league are used for league expenses; however, a float is required to cover necessary expenses throughout the year and in advance of events, such as room and trailer rentals.

The Treasurer's report was approved by Chris Pazzacalli and Jordy Robins, and the motion was carried.

e. Social Media Coordinator

Collin was not in attendance due to the loss of a close friend on the day of the AGM. Margaret acknowledged the excellent work he has been doing to share league information and ensure dart players are kept informed.

f. Head Statistician

The statistics spreadsheet was updated by Eric this year, making the stats recording process much easier and more efficient.

Captains submitted score sheets promptly this year, and reminders were not required.

8. New Business

- a. New Format – Spares
- b. Now Two Divisions
- c. Deadline for fees – June 27, 2026

A question was raised about whether there would still be a playoff for the middle teams moving up or down between divisions, and this was confirmed.

Chantelle made a motion to reinstate the sportsmanship award with required participation. The motion was seconded by Jordy and carried by majority vote (25/35).

Chantelle made a motion to apply a three-point penalty if an MSLP from the opposing team is not selected on the score sheet. The motion was seconded by Hedy.

The motion was carried by majority vote (20/35).

A question was raised by Jordy regarding whether a decision had been made about this year's banquet. Margret advised that the Social last year was received well and will be done again this year.
